Welcome to a new and exciting year of Junior Golf at Transit Valley. We have made a few innovative changes to our Jr. Golf

Program, which include: 1-Day Golf Camps, league opportunities, competitive on course preparation and new "Play with the Pro". This year there will be three levels of golf at Transit Valley.

Eligibility

All children and grandchildren of Golf and House Members between the ages of 8 and 17 years of age are eligible for Junior Golf. Children between the ages of 5 and 7 are eligible for Pee Wee Golf.

New for 2009

"Play with the Pro" is here for the kids. If your son or daughter signs up for the Birdie or Eagle program they will have an opportunity to play 9 Holes with one of the Golf Professionals at TVCC.

The **Par Program** includes admission to all 10 Jr. Golf lessons and play afterwards.

The **Birdie Program** includes everything above plus participation in a 1-Day Golf Camp at TVCC, which includes "Play with the Pro".

The **Eagle Program** includes Birdie Program benefits and participation in a 1-Day camp. It also includes two Play with the Pro's, comprehensive Jr. Club Fitting and video swing analysis (weather permitting)
