Transit Valley has the finest Junior Golf program in the area – designed to make the Junior Golf experience better for all. The focus of our program is based on the following five core elements of golf development: Improving golf fundamentals, sportsmanship, objective assessment of skills, discussion of how fitness and nutrition affect performance, and games and drills designed to improve play and have fun.

The Golf Staff is committed to providing the proper level of instruction based on the ability, motivation and skill of each junior. Our professional staff has over 70 combined years of teaching the game to juniors.

The Junior Golf program is divided between divisions: Pee Wee, Beginner, 3-hole, 6-hole, 9-hole, and 18-hole. Children and/or grandchildren of Golf and House Members between the ages of 5 to 7 are eligible to participate in the Pee Wee Golf program, while juniors between the ages of 8 to 17 are eligible for Junior Golf. Juniors are placed into groups based on their abilities and previous golf experience. Each group (excluding Pee Wee) comes out twice a week for one lesson and to play on the course two times. At the end of the Junior Golf season we hold a Junior Golf Championship, followed by a banquet.
